

**ORDINANCE 2026-08**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 (ANIMAL CONTROL AND REGULATION), ARTICLE 1 (ANIMALS AND FOWL GENERALLY), SECTION 2-102 (KEEPING ANIMALS), OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CANEY, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CANEY, KANSAS**

**Section 1.** That Chapter 2 (Animal Control and Regulation), Article 1 (Animals and Fowl Generally), Section 2-102 (Keeping Animals), of the Code of the City of Caney, Kansas, be and is hereby amended as follows:

**2-102. Keeping Animals.**


- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Article, the keeping of any animal or fowl within the city limits is prohibited.
- (b) Notwithstanding any provisions of this Article to the contrary, a person may apply for a city license to keep and maintain cattle, sheep and goats within the city limits, subject to the following conditions:
  - (1) The person shall apply for a license of a form provided by the city clerk and shall include all information requested on the license form and be accompanied by a non-refundable license application fee in the amount of \$5.00. The license shall be valid for a period of 60 days and may be renewed every 60 days, subject to the payment of a renewal fee in the amount of \$5.00 and inspection by the Code Compliance Officer if deemed necessary;
  - (2) There shall be a minimum of 200 square feet per animal within an enclosed fence or pen, where the animal(s) shall be kept at all times, except when the animal(s) are in the process of being transported;
  - (3) Such enclosure shall be no closer than 25 feet from the person's property line and no closer than 50 feet to any residence, including the residence of the person harboring or keeping said animal(s); and
  - (4) The person harboring or keeping said animal(s) shall properly maintain the fenced or penned area, including the regular removal of animal waste from the area and appropriate fly and insect control.

(c) A person convicted of a violation of Section 2-102(b) shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$150.00.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect upon publication of a summary hereof in the official City newspaper.

**Section 3.** Any other ordinance or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, is hereby repealed.
